# Senior Photographs

#### 1. Senior Portrait

Your senior portrait can be any type of pose, horizontal or vertical, head shot or full body. We might need to crop your portrait to fit into the yearbook 's format, though.

- File format: JPEG
- File size: no smaller than 600 X 800 pixels.







## 2. Baby Photo

Submit one baby photo. Photos should be of ages newborn – 8 years old. Scan or take a photo, with your cell phone, of paper photographs.



# 3. Pet Photo(s)

Submit one photo for each of your pets. Label each photo with the pet's name.



# 4. Younger Years Photos

Submit photos from your child's **younger school years -before high school.** Photos should be of school related events and **not** personal events (birthday parties or family vacations)

# Senior Paragraph


## **Senior Paragraph**

The paragraph goes next to your senior portrait in your "senior section". There is no set format for your paragraph. You may write a little or a lot. However, a common format is to include the following:

- a "thank you" to parents, siblings and friends,
- a list of favorite memories with friends,
- a list of sports, clubs and activities from grade 9 12,
- a favorite quote.

GUIDELINES: Keep it school appropriate. Only a list of friend's names may be abbreviated, to save space. If you have the space, you may include photographs. The yearbook staff has the right to edit your paragraph, but we will inform you of any changes.

On October 1st the books revert to the regular price of \$65.00 (Same price for the past 10 years).
