

DIGITAL ART STUDIO

This course will focus on creating fine art in a digital medium. Assignments will emphasize traditional artistic skills such as visual problem solving, composition, drawing & painting and art history. Instead of paint, brushes, and pencils students will use their ipad, a stylus(or apple pencil) and drawing and painting Apps (Sketchbook, Procreate and Fresco). By the end of the semester students will develop their own personal style of expression



STUDENTS WILL...

1. Students create digital art that shows an understanding of representational, abstract and conceptual art.

 Students will demonstrate knowledge of the elements and principles of design in their art.
Students will develop their own style of expression.

4. Students will explore art history and use it as inspiration for their own work.

5. Students will critique and reflect upon their work to better understand the creative process.

6. Strengthen their creative problem solving and

critical thinking skills using the creative process.



Make sure you read and understand **Guidelines for Use of the Internet and Georgetown's Internal Network** in the student handbook.




LIFE HAPPENS!
